CHAMBER UNVEILS "CANANDAIGUA SUMMER NIGHTS" MURAL

On Dec. 16, the Chamber unveiled an eighth and final panel to their octagon mural painting that welcomes thousands of visitors each year in the Canandaigua Visitor Center.

The first seven panels were painted by the late Fred Johnson, a well-known local artist. The existing panels have been in place since soon after the Chamber moved from the A-Frame building on Routes 5 & 20 to their current location at 113 South Main Street about 10 years ago. Johnson's painting beautifully represents many Canandaigua "must see" and historical places including Sonnenberg Mansion & Gardens State Historic Park, Finger Lakes Casino & Racetrack, Canandaigua Wine, the Canandaigua Lady, Downtown Canandaigua, Canandaigua Lake, Granger Homestead, Bristol Mountain, the Bath House, Bare Hill, Ontario County Court House and City Hall.

One of Johnson's students, Christopher Wheat, a locally and nationally renowned artist, was asked by the Canandaigua Chamber, in honor of their centennial anniversary, to complete the final panel of the octagon mural. The final panel named, "Canandaigua Summer Nights" by Wheat, contains Constellation Brands Marvin Sands Performing Arts Center (CMAC), the Boat Houses, Squaw Island, the New York Wine & Culinary Center, Canandaigua Lake, Kershaw Park Gazebo with Chamber Fountain, and more. Wheat says Johnson was "my mentor, my teacher, and a good friend". To be asked to do the painting "was a very special honor".

Chamber President/CEO, Alison Grems, says "Christopher Wheat did a phenomenal job on the final piece. We'd like to thank a great Chamber supporter, and 100 year member, Canandaigua National Bank & Trust, for offering to assist with the funding to make this mural possible. It's a wonderful addition that will be a new landmark in Canandaigua to be enjoyed by many. The unveiling was a perfect ending to our centennial anniversary year shared with close friends and supporters of the Chamber."

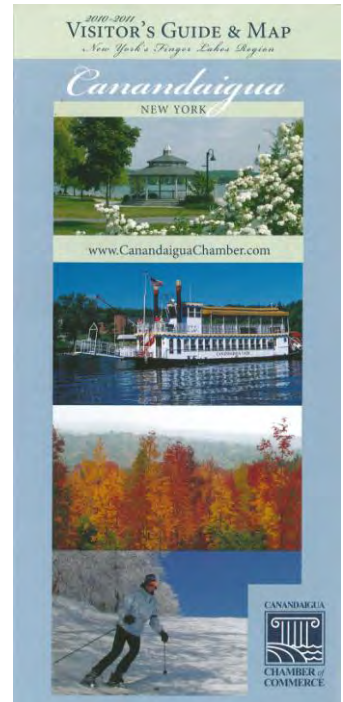

FLCC Among Fastest Growing Community Colleges

Finger Lakes Community College ranks among the fastest-growing two-year colleges in the nation, according to Community College Week magazine. The Nov. 29 issue of the national publication ranked FLCC 40th on a list of the top 50 fastest-growing community colleges with an enrollment of 5,000 to 9,999. The ranking accompanied an article on surges in enrollment at community colleges across the country amid the economic downturn. The ranking was based on FLCC's fall 2009 enrollment of 6,699 full- and part-time students, a 17 percent increase in one year. FLCC's fall 2010 enrollment rose an additional 3.5 percent to 6,935 full- and part-time students.
